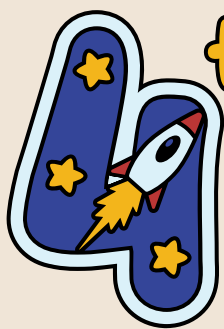
The "Pancake Manor Fest" was a fun day for first graders! They sang, acted, and wore colorful costumes, making everyone smile.

Teamwork and creativity were key as the students worked together to make their models. It was a great way to bring the Olympic Games to life!

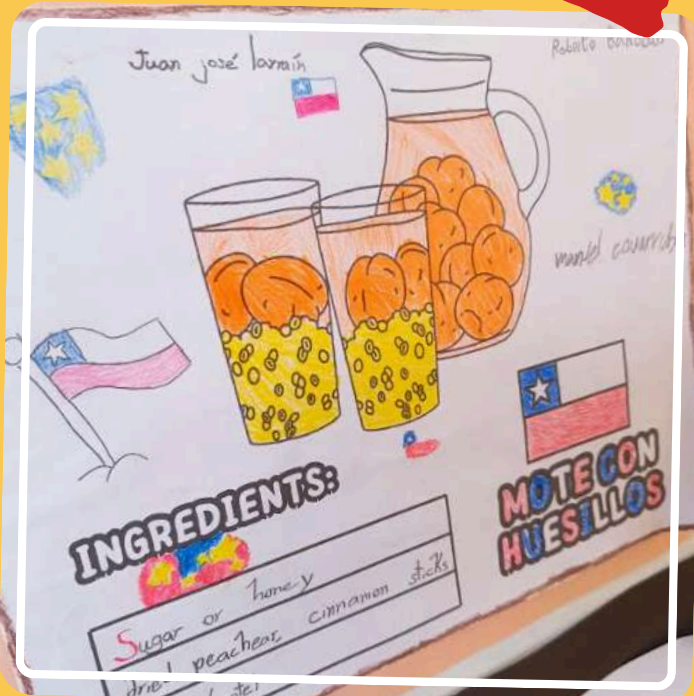

How to make "Pastel" de choclo



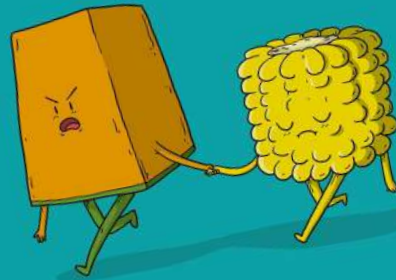
- Cook ground beef with onions and spices.

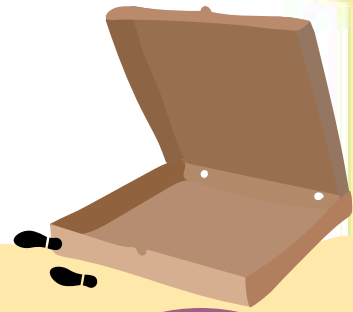
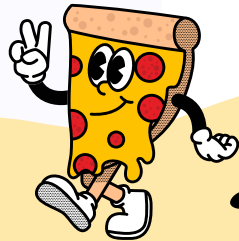

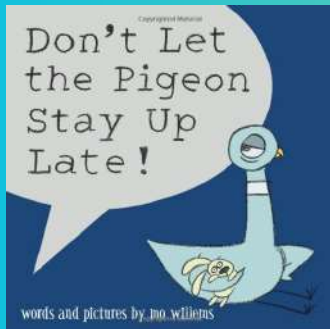


Fantastic Mr. Fox

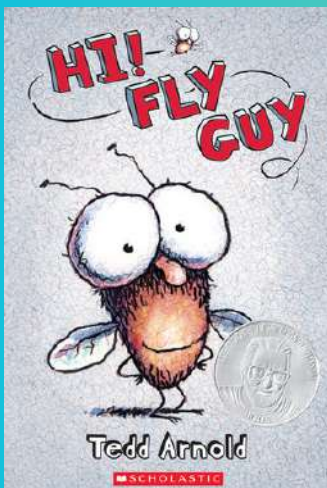


Don't Let the Pigeon Stay Up Late!

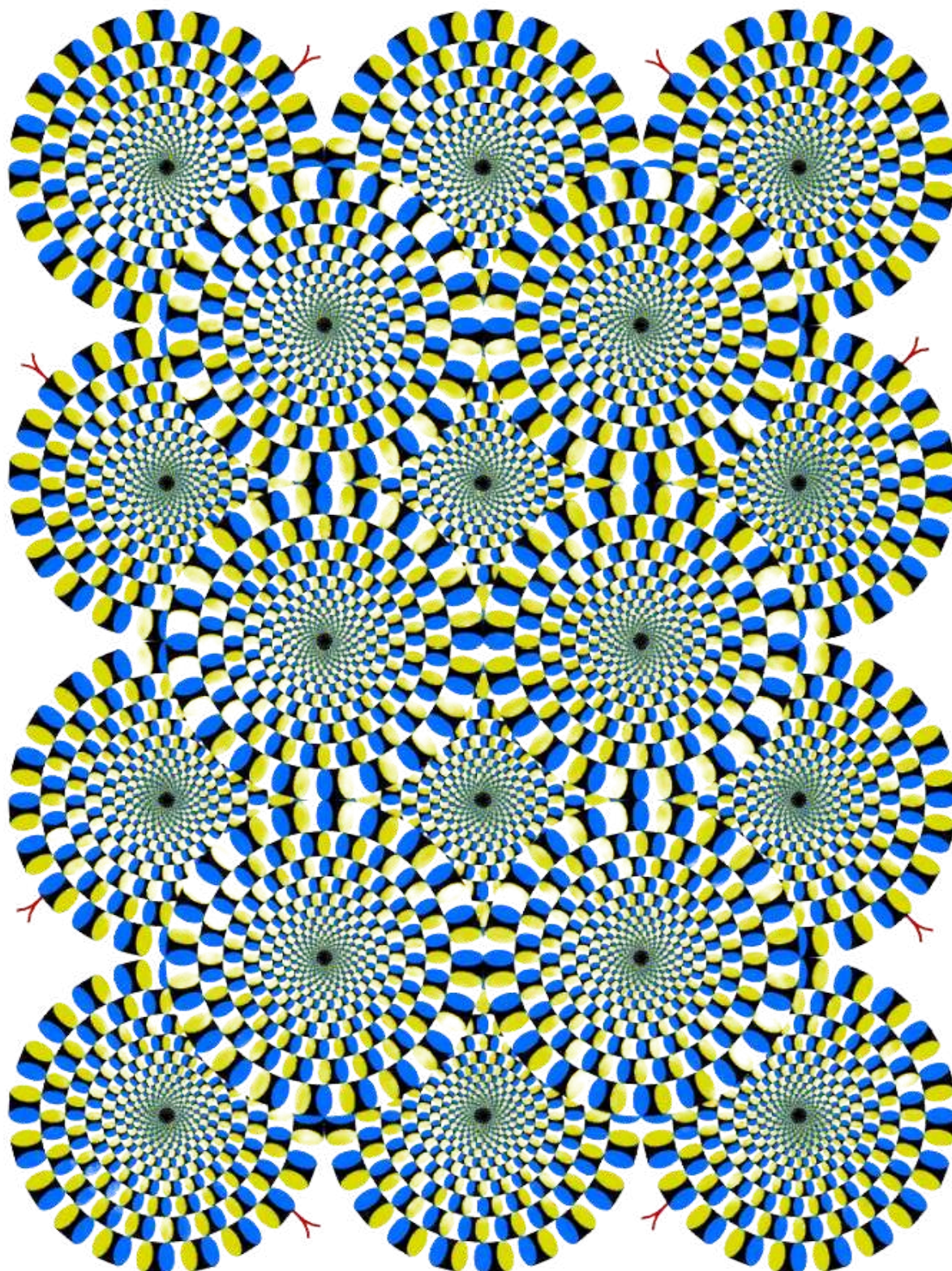
