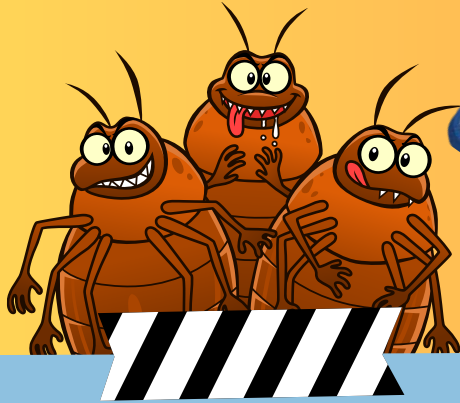

The day was packed with learning, exploration, and joy—a memory they would always treasure.







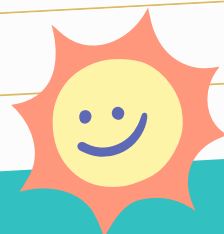
# FLEA Market!

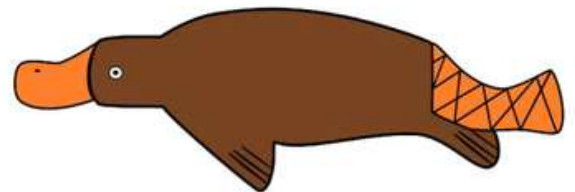
